TERM 4 - KEY EVENTS, PROGRAMMES AND NOTIFICATIONS

REFLECTIONS ON TERM 3

- 1. Term 3 has been both inspiring and eventful, as students participated in a range of activities aimed to enrich their educational experience. ASSESSMENT MATTERS

GCE N-LEVEL EXAMINATION & CHANGES TO TERM 4 TIMETABLE

4. The GCE N-Level Examination will commence on 15 September 2025, Monday. Hence, the school's reporting and dismissal times for Secondary 1 to 3 will be adjusted in Term 4. Secondary 4 students will also have a revised daily schedule during this period. <u>Annex A provides a summary of the Assessment Schedule</u>, Dismissal Adjustments and Key Events. Please note that you will only receive the information for your child's/ward's level.

SECONDARY 1 TO 3 END-OF-YEAR ASSESSMENTS

- 5. Secondary 1 to 3 students will have their End-of-Year Assessments from 3 October 2025 to 10 October 2025.
- 6. Marking Day for Secondary 1 to 3 will be on 13 October 2025, Monday. All students will not need to report to school on that day. Please refer to the assessment schedule in Annex A.
- 7. Students will be dismissed after their last paper for each day of the exam.
- 8. For students who do not have a paper on a particular day, they are not required to report to school on that day.
- 9. It is important to note that your child/ward will require a medical certificate if he/she is unable to attend the examination. **No parent's/guardian's letter will be accepted**.

- 11. As part of the ITE Skills Subject Certificate (ISSC) requirements, all Secondary 3 students will need to participate in the IEP from 27 October to 22 November 2025. Please do not plan for any family holiday programmes during this period as it is still considered curriculum time for our students.
- 12. We thank all S3 parents in advance for supporting the IEP. We believe that real-world work experience will bring much benefits to our students.

CCA STAND-DOWN

13. Due to the End-of-Year Assessment, all CCA activities for Secondary 1 to 3 students will stand down from 26 September 2025, Friday. CCA afternoon activities will resume after 13 October 2025, Monday.

16. We will conclude the school term with our annual Crest Open House, which warmly welcomes Primary 6 students. To prepare for a smooth event, a dry run session is scheduled for 24 November 2025, Monday. The Open House itself will take place from 25 November 2025, Tuesday to 29 November 2025, Saturday.

Parents/Guardians will receive updates on their child's participation via Parents Gateway at a later date. Please note that these dates are tentative and subject to change.

STUDENT MANAGEMENT - ATTIRE AND GROOMING

17. As we begin Term 4, we would like to remind you of our school's grooming standards to ensure all students maintain a neat and appropriate appearance. Please take a moment to review your child's uniform, hair length and style, nail care, accessories and overall presentation before they return to school.

We will be conducting a check on students' attire and grooming during the first week of the term. Students who do not meet the established grooming guidelines will be asked to rectify their appearance within a stipulated period. A second check will then be conducted during the second week to ensure compliance. Should students still not meet the established grooming guidelines after the second check, they will be asked to rectify their appearance before attending classes.

In addition, they can continue to use their Crest email accounts (ending with crestsec.edu.sg) until 14 October 2025, Tuesday. Their iCON email accounts (ending with students.edu.sg) will be closed on 31 December 2025, Wednesday. Students are requested to backup any files they wish to keep from their Crest and iCON email accounts before the account closure dates.
