TERM 3 - KEY EVENTS, PROGRAMMES & NOTIFICATIONS

REFLECTIONS ON TERM 2

1. At the end of Term 2, we conducted our "Keep Right Programme" with fun-filled activities such as the cross-country race, Mother Tongue cultural activities, interclass games, learning journeys to Little India, Chinatown, Bird Paradise, the Zoo and Gardens by the Bay across various levels.

On 30 May 2025, parents/guardians, students and teachers came together for the Parent-Student-Teacher Conference (PSTC). The students were asked to take charge and lead the PSTC while the teachers and parents/guardians listened attentively to the students. Traditionally, teachers would share with parents/guardians the progress of the students. However, allowing the students to lead the PSTC and giving them the time and opportunity to share their experiences and reflections of Semester 1 was a powerful demonstration of their learning and growth. We would like to thank all parents/guardians for your continued support in working with the school to develop our Crestans.

2. The Awards Committee organised our annual Awards Day on 23 May 2025 to recognise students who demonstrated outstanding performance in their academic and vocational assessments in 2024. Awards were given to students at various levels for subject excellence and all-round achievement. It was our honour to welcome Ms Yasmin Hannah Ramle, a valued member of our Board of Directors, as the Guest of Honour for the event.

We were especially delighted to have our award recipients' parents join us in the ceremony this year—the first time since the COVID-19 pandemic. Their presence added a meaningful touch to the celebration, highlighting the importance of home-school partnership in our students' growth. To acknowledge the strong home-school partnership, CrestPal Recognition Awards were presented to eight parents.

As part of the event, we also showcased our new *Discovery Module* curriculum, which gives our lower secondary students a hands-on experience in vocational subjects. SCHOOL ATTENDANCE AND ABSENTEEISM

- 4. In line with the MOE's guidelines on attendance taking, the school will be implementing the following from Term 3, 2025:
 - a. <u>Parent Letters</u>. Students who are unwell are advised to seek help from a medical professional by seeing a doctor. A valid Medical Certificate (MC) must be produced for a student who has missed any scheduled tests or examinations. In line with the new attendance taking guidelines, the school accepts **only up to five parent letters per semester**.
 - b. <u>Absence due to Non-Medical Matters</u>. To maximise the learning of your child/ward during the school terms, please refrain from taking your child/ward away from school during term time. Students should not take leave during the school term for non-essential personal and family overseas travel. Any absences of such nature will be **marked as non-valid reasons**.
