Dear Parent/Guardian,

PARENT OPTION FORM FOR AFTER-SCHOOL DMA SETTINGS

Your child's/ward's personal learning device (PLD) has been installed with Device Management Application (DMA) software to ensure that he/she uses the PLD for learning in a safer digital learning environment and to prevent misuse of the device. The DMA will be funded by MOE and will be uninstalled from the device when your child/ward graduates / leaves the school.

DMA software helps your child's/ward's PLD to do the following:

- Updates and manages the PLDs, protects PLDs from malicious software (eg. computer viruses).
- Enables teachers to manage the student's use of the PLD during lesson time to improve classroom management and support effective teaching and learning.
- Enables the school and/or parents to better supervise and set helpful limits for students' use of PLDs after school.
- 2. The following DMA settings will be in place while the student is in school as a default:
 - MOE and the school will set the level of web content filtering, including filtering out social media sites, pornography, gambling, extremist and violence-related sites
 - For PLD usage time, students will be able to use their laptops from 7.00 a.m. to 11.00pm on all days.
 - The school will determine the applications and programmes to be installed to support teaching and learning.
 - A parent account will be enabled to allow you to monitor your child's/ward's PLD activities and partner the school to ensure the student's cyber well-being.
- 3. Student's school hours are from 7.00am to 3.00pm. For parents who wish to have the above settings to apply even after school hours, you <u>do not need</u> to complete this form.
- 4. For parents who prefer alternative DMA settings <u>after school hours</u>, please fill in <u>Sections 1, 2</u> <u>and 3</u>. Please refer to Annex A.
- 5. Parents can request to change your choice of DMA settings at any time by contacting the school. However, please note that changes to the DMA after-school options will only take effect at the end of every month.
